The Bill Greehey Refineries complex in Corpus Christi, Texas, is two plants. Valero commissioned the grass-roots Corpus Christi refinery in 1983, now referred to as the West plant. This facility is considered one of the most complex refineries in the world. The East plant was acquired in 2001.
