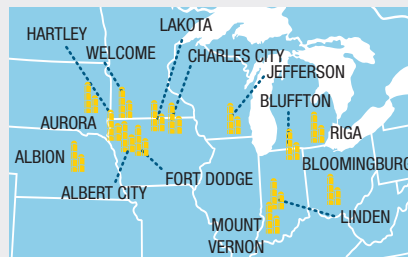

THE BLOOMINGTONBURG PLANT PRODUCES

Ethanol, an environmentally friendly, high-octane renewable fuel that is blended with gasoline

Dried distillers grains with solubles (DDGS) and modified (or wet) distillers grains with solubles (MDGS), sold as high-value livestock feed for beef and dairy cattle, swine and poultry

Fuel- and feed-grade corn oil, for renewable diesel or biodiesel production, and livestock feed

The entire kernel of corn is processed.
